Eligibility

Terms

-All applicants that are chosen to be in Team STYT must:

- Aid in executing the events

Duties

-All team members must:

- Participate in meetings
- Be a rotating facilitator (see below)

- Be a rotating note taker (see below)
- Be a project manager (see below)
- Participate in events
- Contribute to maintenance of bylaws
- Commit to checking, responding, and communicating through emails

Project Managers

- Takes on the leadership position of a specific event
- Organizes and assigns tasks within the project
- Keeps people in check and makes sure our time management is up to par
- Is a source of communication

Rotating Facilitator

- Facilitate meetings
- Establish the meeting agenda
- Email agenda before each meeting
- Develop and implement meeting topics and activities

Rotating Note Taker

- Constantly keep minute meetings and email them out to members after each meeting
- Take attendance

Dismissal of Internship

- If member dismisses any responsibilities or disregards terms to being a member, they will be dismissed

Option for Resignation

- All members have the option to resign from internship
