Thank you for your interest in applying for SAVE's 40-hour training to become a Domestic Violence Advocate! Should your application be selected, you will be contacted for a zoom/phone interview to go over the next steps.

Answering FAQs:

- Training sessions on July 8, 22, and 29 will be held in person at Fremont Library
- Training sessions on July 13, 15, 20, and 27 will be held virtually on Zoom
- Training dates/hours are: Wednesdays (9am-1pm) and Fridays (9am-4:30pm), July 8-29.
- All trainees are requested to be on-site or logged on by 8:45 AM.
- For in-person sessions, light snacks and beverages will be provided. Please make your own arrangements for our 1-hour lunch break on these days. There is a cooler and microwave on-site, and there are several restaurant/café options within a mile, and a Starbucks ¼ of a mile away.
- We have limited seats open for the Summer 2022 training
- Priority will be given to volunteers who are willing and able to volunteer with SAVE, during business hours (9-5, M-F).
- You must be able to attend all sessions to get your certification and qualify as a direct service volunteer.
- No makeup sessions will be offered.
- All instruction will be in English.
- All trainees must successfully complete a background check, provided by SAVE.
- A payment of \$75 is due on the first day of training. Trainees must complete 100 hours of volunteer service post-training before they are eligible to receive their certificate. If you complete the training but are unable to complete 100 hours of service, you can receive your certificate by paying the full fee of \$350.
